While the curriculum is provided, teachers are responsible for planning and delivering instruction to match the needs and abilities of the students. In addition to teaching one of our classes, our new director will coordinate and manage school events, as well as our b'nai mitzvah program and work closely with our Religious School Parent Committee.
